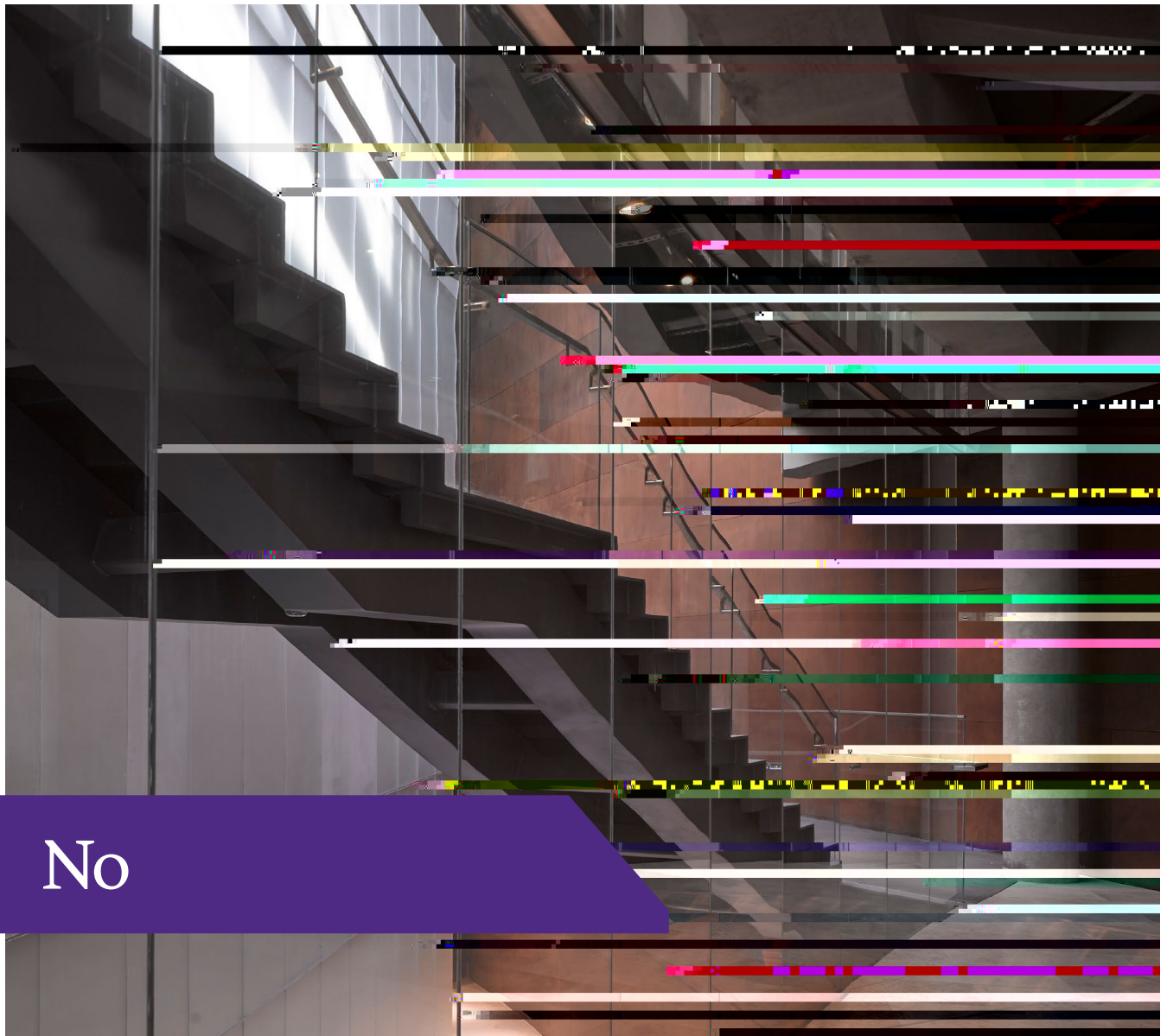





Orders of Protection or Restraining Orders

1. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of domestic violence against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit such an act.

2. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of sexual assault against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit such an act.

3. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of stalking against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit such an act.

4. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of harassment against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit such an act.

Information and Options for Survivors of Sexual Misconduct Abroad

1. Survivors of sexual misconduct abroad may seek assistance from the Department of State's Office of Overseas Citizen Services (OCS).

2. OCS provides information and referrals to local law enforcement, medical services, and other resources in the host country.

3. OCS also provides support and advocacy services to survivors of sexual misconduct abroad.

Miscellaneous

1. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of domestic violence against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit such an act.

2. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of sexual assault against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit such an act.

3. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of stalking against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit such an act.

Clery Act Crimes and Clery Act Geography Definitions

Clery Act Crimes

(a) Rape—The offense of rape is defined as the carnal knowledge of another person, accomplished by force or threat of force, or by the use of a deadly weapon, or by the use of physical or psychological coercion, or by the use of any other means that overcomes the victim's resistance.

(b) Fondle—The offense of fondle is defined as the intentional touching of the private parts of another person for the purpose of sexual arousal, gratification, or abuse, or the intentional touching of another person's private parts.

(c) Sexual Assault—The offense of sexual assault is defined as the intentional touching of another person's private parts, or the intentional touching of another person's private parts for the purpose of sexual arousal, gratification, or abuse, or the intentional touching of another person's private parts.

(d) Sexual Coercion—The offense of sexual coercion is defined as the intentional touching of another person's private parts, or the intentional touching of another person's private parts for the purpose of sexual arousal, gratification, or abuse, or the intentional touching of another person's private parts.

(e) Sexual Exploitation—The offense of sexual exploitation is defined as the intentional touching of another person's private parts, or the intentional touching of another person's private parts for the purpose of sexual arousal, gratification, or abuse, or the intentional touching of another person's private parts.

(f) Stalking—The offense of stalking is defined as the repeated, unwanted attention or communication directed at a person that causes the person to feel fear or distress.

(g) Harassment—The offense of harassment is defined as the repeated, unwanted attention or communication directed at a person that causes the person to feel fear or distress.

(h) Intimidation—The offense of intimidation is defined as the intentional or recklessness infliction of fear or distress upon another person by the use of force or threat of force, or by the use of a deadly weapon, or by the use of physical or psychological coercion, or by the use of any other means that overcomes the victim's resistance.

(i) Physical Assault—The offense of physical assault is defined as the intentional or recklessness infliction of physical injury upon another person.

(j) Sexual Assault—The offense of sexual assault is defined as the intentional touching of another person's private parts, or the intentional touching of another person's private parts for the purpose of sexual arousal, gratification, or abuse, or the intentional touching of another person's private parts.

(k) Sexual Coercion—The offense of sexual coercion is defined as the intentional touching of another person's private parts, or the intentional touching of another person's private parts for the purpose of sexual arousal, gratification, or abuse, or the intentional touching of another person's private parts.

(l) Sexual Exploitation—The offense of sexual exploitation is defined as the intentional touching of another person's private parts, or the intentional touching of another person's private parts for the purpose of sexual arousal, gratification, or abuse, or the intentional touching of another person's private parts.


