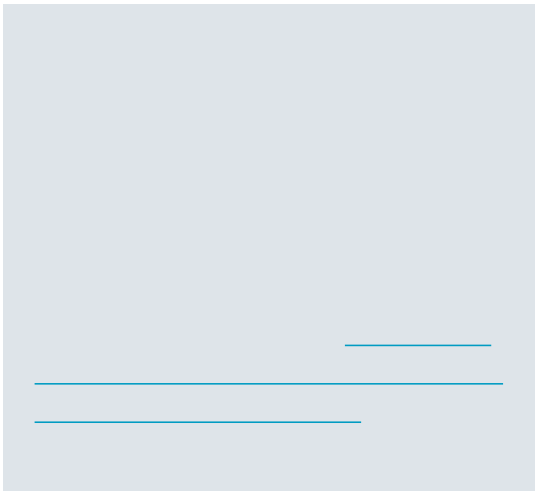
Aligns with the Autumn Equinox, which often falls on September 22nd.
