Evaluation of Satisfactory Academic Progress

Evanston Office of Graduate Financial Aid will evaluate federal financial aid Satisfactory Academic Progress at the end of each academic year (at the end of the spring quarter) or at the end of each quarter, if a student is enrolled in a year-long program spanning 3-4 quarters. Reviews will occur once grades are published in the University's system and will also include a review of courses attempted, pace toward graduation, and GPA.

SAP Suspension

Students who do not meet the terms of federal financial aid Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) will be subject to a SAP Suspension and will not be eligible to receive federal financial aid during the financial aid suspension term. In order to reinstate federal financial aid eligibility after a SAP suspension, students must meet the following criteria for reinstatement:

- Complete 100% of courses enrolled

documentation/statements from academic advisers, professors, professional health care workers, etc., may be requested. The appeal will be reviewed by a committee chaired by the Director of **Evanston Office of Graduate Financial Aid**
